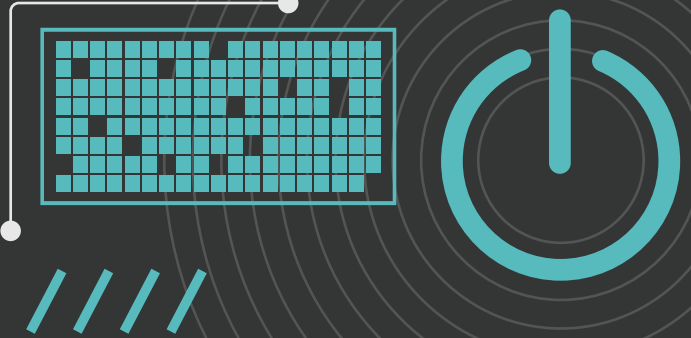


DIGITAL APPRENTICESHIPS

CALDERDALE

If you think learning whilst working would suit you, then an apprenticeship could be for you.

An apprenticeship is a job with training, open to anyone over the age of 16. Apprentices work alongside experienced staff, earn a wage and get paid time off to learn the things they need to do their job. This leaflet is about digital apprenticeships in Calderdale. This is because employers say they are struggling to find people with the digital skills they need.

Apprenticeships are available at different levels. Level 3 is equivalent to A levels, and levels 6 and 7 are degree level and higher. The level you do depends on the job you want to do, and on your qualifications and experience.

LEVEL 3 ADVANCED APPRENTICESHIPS

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSE grades 9-4 (A*-C) including English and maths, may be required.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Level 3 qualifications may be required, plus related work experience.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Level 3 qualifications are likely to be required, plus related work experience.

Employers say some of the most in-demand digital skills are artificial intelligence (AI), IT support and troubleshooting, and cyber security.

In 2023/24, some of the digital apprenticeships with the most starts were data analyst (6,750 starts), data technician (6,160 starts) and information communications technician (3,090 starts).

In 2023/24 in West Yorkshire, over 1,100 people started an ICT apprenticeship.

In 2023/24 in England, over 27,000 people started an ICT apprenticeship.

Check out the 'careers' or 'vacancies' sections on company websites and on their social media platforms.

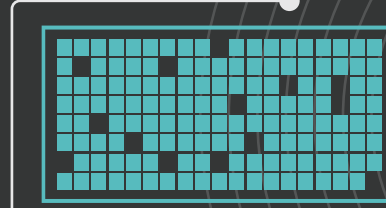
SPEAK TO PEOPLE

DEVELOPING YOUR DIGITAL SKILLS



If you're applying for digital apprenticeships, it's a good idea to have some relevant experience and skills. Ideas of things you could do include:

- Ask friends and family or use www.yell.com to identify companies to contact about work experience.
- Keep up to date with the latest technology. YouTube tutorials are available in a wide range of digital subjects.
- Learn coding or app developer skills through websites such as <https://arcade.makecode.com>
- Do some programming, content creation or web design and build up a portfolio of work that you can talk about when applying for apprenticeships.
